

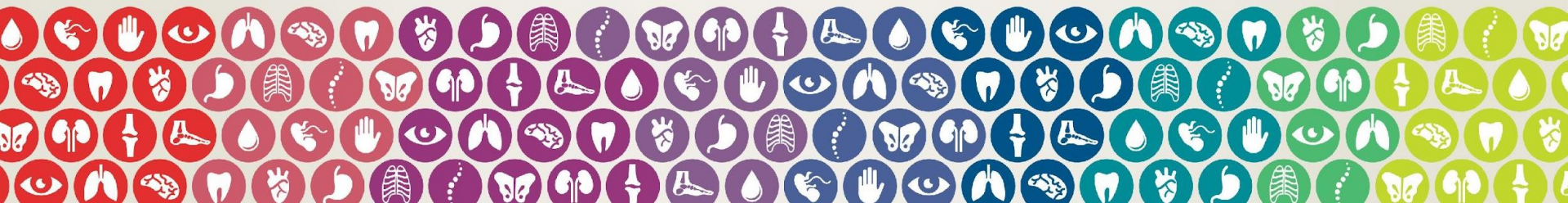

# ADOPTED RESOLUTION

## **Emergency Medicine to Support Evidence-Based Policy Reforms of the Criminal Justice System and Equitable Health Care for Incarcerated Patients**

EMRA supports evidence-based policy reforms of the criminal justice system that contribute to individual and public health.

EMRA recognizes that incarcerated people form a vulnerable patient population with higher rates of chronic medical conditions including substance use disorders. As front-line practitioners in caring for patients who present while under the custody of law enforcement, EMRA:

1. Supports required and confidential screening of people under custody of law enforcement to identify medical conditions including substance use disorders, and prompt treatment of these conditions.
2. Upholds that addiction treatment including evidence-based harm reduction strategies, counseling, and prescribed treatments such as buprenorphine or naltrexone must be provided to incarcerated people who give consent for treatment.
3. Advocates for transition services and rehabilitation initiatives that support the comprehensive medical needs of patients upon release from incarceration. These needs include but are not limited to regular follow-up and access to addiction treatment to reduce the risk of relapse, reincarceration, and overdose death.

# ACTION ITEMS UPDATE

## Residents Bill of Rights:

A survey was created to characterize the effects of emergency medicine residency program closure on affected residents. The goal is to identify the areas of difficulty for such a transition and ideally create a road map for residents of future closures as well as find areas for potential support from larger residency organizations. The proposal is undergoing IRB approval through CHRISTUS Spohn Hospital at Corpus Christi- Shoreline. Upon IRB approval, the survey will be released through the EMRA listserv.

## Social Workers in the ED Working Group

A workgroup was created to compile best practices related to educating residents and medical students on ED care models that include social workers and care coordinators. The group is finalizing a manuscript that will be available soon!
